

Undergraduate Course Descriptions

Course Descriptions: Each course is worth 3 credit hours. Credit hours are non-transferrable.

LEADERSHIP

Leadership Theories

This course is designed to increase your knowledge of the different leadership theories and their historical developments with the emphases on integrating those theories with biblical principles.

Principles of Christian Leadership

This course explores the topic of leadership from a biblical and theological perspective. Essential biblical principles bearing on the purpose and character of leadership will be examined. Instances of leadership in the Old and New Testaments will be analyzed within their biblical context, and in terms of contemporary understanding of leadership, with special focus on the leadership of Jesus Christ as seen in the New Testament.

Cross-Cultural Leadership

This course is a study of organizational leadership and decision-making skills essential for all leaders in intercultural environments. Theories of culture are examined and applied in relation to leadership style and practices, as well as organizational communication across cultural groups. Development and leadership of teams are explored in an intercultural environment, including leadership of virtual teams. The role of culture in the success of joint ventures and partnerships will be investigated.

Christian Leadership and Ministerial Ethics

This is a study of Christian ethics for the everyday life with sound biblical principles, practical applications for professionals, and problem aspects encountered in the ministry.

Church Management and Leadership

This course is designed to give church and ministry leaders a clear biblical understanding and foundational framework of the essential identity, organizational patterns, and leadership role of the local church. You will examine the theology of the church and culture, organizational change and developmental constructs, planning and team building systems, and leadership formation.

Christian Finances

This course examines the biblical foundation of financial management. The course will help you apply those principles to personal, ministry, and business finances. You will also cover overcoming pitfalls in financial management.
