

Undergraduate Course Descriptions

Course Descriptions: Each course is worth 3 credit hours. Credit hours are non-transferrable.

OUTREACH

Evangelism

This course is a study of the Biblical injunctions to evangelize, with an emphasis on developing the skills of personal evangelism and equipping others to share their faith.

World Religions

A comparative study of the main world religious systems as related to the Biblical principles of Christianity. Modern cults are addressed along with major points in witnessing to adherents of non-Christian religions.

Biblical Theology of Missions

A course designed to introduce the you to the biblical, theme of *missio Dei*; theological, historical, and practical bases for Christian missions. Special attention is given to contemporary issues in missions as well as current ways to do missions. You will be challenged to respond personally to the biblical theology of missions and to evaluate the church's contemporary involvement in the *missio Dei*.

World Missions Strategies

This course will challenge you to gain a greater understanding and passion for world missions. The strategic context of missions has been changing; aspects of missions such as teamwork, money, technology, and contextualization. We need to realize the strategic trends that are occurring and how they impact the global church.

World Christian Perspectives

This course will explore and examine the history of missions from A.D. 30 to the twentieth century. As a survey of Christian missions over the past two millennia, the focus will be on how God has worked through the Holy Spirit in making known His Gospel. You will study the different methodologies in their historical context to help form relevant strategies for today.

Cross-Cultural Communication

This is an introduction to social norms and values in different cultures. It includes principles for the missionary to use in relating Christian moral standards to values in another culture.

Short-Term Missions

This course will introduce you to the Biblical foundation, importance, methods, and financing of short-term mission work. Special emphasis is placed upon methods of evangelism, the how and why of church building construction, and the methods of raising funds.
